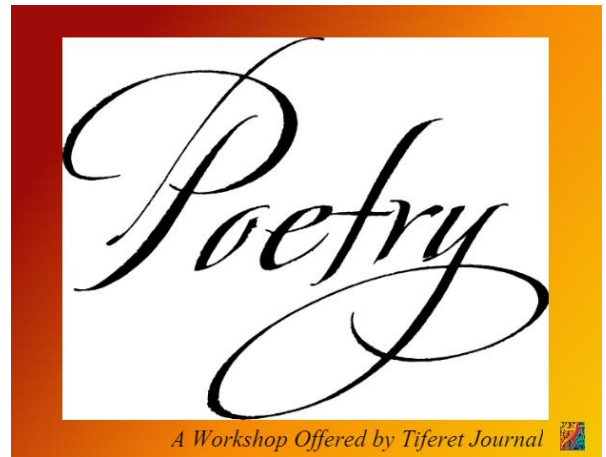


Taking Your Poem to the Next Level
